


Sterilizing Cartridge - User Manual

When the watermaker is off:

1. Turn the 3 way valve to the **fresh water position**, with the regulating valve on the control panel totally counterclockwise, after 15 minutes turn It to the closed position to cut off all water supply (see image below).



- 2. Open the sterilizing cartridge by removing the lid and the plastic top grid.
- 3. Make sure the foam pad is correctly placed at the bottom of the cartridge.
- 4. Pour the powder into the cartridge directly on top of the foam pad.
- 5. Put the top grid back into the cartridge.
- Close the lid, making sure to turn it so that the white seal is facing outward (see image→)
- 7. Remove the 5-micron filter located in the pre-filter bowl and replace it with the sterilizing cartridge (see images below).

For Freedom, Cruise and DUO models:



For Compact and CAD models:



- 8. Close the pre-filter bowl (check that the O-ring at the top of the bowl is correctly seated).
- 9. Turn the 3-way valve to the fresh water position. The bowl will fill with water and the sterilizing powder will dissolve.

Leave a bit of sterilizing powder on the foam pad and turn the valve back to the closed position.

IMPORTANT: Three hours after the sterilization procedure, it is essential to rinse the membranes for 5 minutes to eliminate any excess sterilizing powder. To do so, turn the 3-way valve to the fresh water position. Let the water circulate for 5 minutes, then turn the valve back to the **closed position**.

Sterilization is effective for a maximum of 6 months. If this period is exceeded, the full procedure described in this manual must be repeated.

IMPORTANT: Before restarting the watermaker, a complete rinse with fresh water is mandatory. Turn the 3way valve to the fresh water position for 15 minutes. Then turn the 3 -way valve in the closed position to cut off all water supply, remove the sterilizing cartridge and replace it with a new 5 filter.

→ Note: The cartridge is reusable
